## Abbott Indonesia

Abbott has been operating in Indonesia for 37 years, providing Indonesians with a diverse range of nutrition, pharmaceutical and medical products, and diagnostic tests. Abbott has more than 350 employees in Indonesia.

### Primary Businesses

- **Nutrition Products** – Abbott offers a variety of nutrition products for infants, children, active adults and patients with special dietary needs. Key products include PediaSure<sup>®</sup>, Isomil Plus<sup>®</sup> and Ensure<sup>®</sup>.
- **Pharmaceuticals** – Core therapeutic areas include infectious diseases, epilepsy, bipolar disorders and anesthesia. Key products include, Depakene<sup>®</sup> for the treatment of seizures, the anesthetic Sevorane<sup>®</sup>, multi-vitamin Surbex<sup>®</sup> and the anti-psychotic Depakote<sup>®</sup>.
- **Medical Products** – Key lines of business include laboratory and molecular diagnostics, vascular and diabetes care. Key products include the XIENCE V<sup>™</sup> drug-eluting stent, MULTI-LINK VISION<sup>®</sup> coronary stent system, ARCHITECT<sup>®</sup> laboratory diagnostic instruments, and the personalized blood glucose meters Optium Xceed<sup>™</sup> and Optium Omega<sup>™</sup>.

### Key Facilities

**Abbott Manufacturing Indonesia** – Opened in 1972, this 22,671 square-meter (244,031 square-foot) pharmaceutical manufacturing facility in Cimanggis underwent a major renovation of its pharmaceutical production facility in 2003. The facility has the certificate of Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP) compliance from the Pharmaceutical Inspection Convention Scheme and is GMP compliance certified from The Indonesia National Agency of Food and Drug Control with a level “A” rating.

### Citizenship

Global citizenship is an integral part of Abbott's mission to improve people's lives in Indonesia and around the world. Responsible citizenship is critical to Abbott's long-term competitiveness, and is reflected in how it conducts business as a global company, protects the environment and builds healthier communities.

- Since 2006, Abbott has distributed more than US\$7.2 million in nutritional and pharmaceutical products in Indonesia to expand access to health care and assist in disaster relief and recovery efforts.
- In 2007, Abbott Indonesia built an Integrated Health Clinic in Cimanggis that provides a wide range of health services for low-income pregnant women and young children.
