## Abbott Vietnam

Abbott has been operating in Vietnam for 13 years, providing Vietnamese consumers with a diverse range of nutrition, pharmaceutical and medical products, and diagnostic tests. Abbott has approximately 100 employees in Vietnam.

### Primary Businesses

- **Nutrition Products** – Abbott offers a variety of nutrition products for infants, children, active adults and patients with special dietary needs. Key products include Ensure Gold<sup>®</sup>, Pediasure BA<sup>®</sup>, Glucerna SR<sup>®</sup>, Similac EyeQ<sup>®</sup>, Gain Plus EyeQ<sup>®</sup> and Grow<sup>®</sup>.
- **Pharmaceuticals** – Core therapeutic areas include infectious diseases, metabolic disease, anesthesia and vitamins. Key products include antibiotic Klacid<sup>®</sup>, Sevorane<sup>™</sup> anesthetic, multi-vitamin Surbex<sup>®</sup> and Reductil<sup>®</sup> anti-obesity medicine.
- **Medical Products** – Key lines of business include vascular, laboratory and molecular diagnostics, and diabetes care. Key products include the XIENCE V<sup>™</sup> drug-eluting stent, MULTI-LINK VISION<sup>®</sup> coronary stent system, laboratory diagnostic instruments ARCHITECT<sup>®</sup> and AxSYM<sup>®</sup> and the personalized glucose meter Optium Xceed<sup>™</sup>.

### Citizenship

Global citizenship is an integral part of Abbott's mission to improve people's lives in Vietnam and around the world. Responsible citizenship is critical to Abbott's long-term competitiveness, and is reflected in how it conducts business as a global company, protects the environment and builds healthier communities.

- Since 2006, Abbott has distributed more than US\$2.2 million in nutritional and pharmaceutical products in Vietnam to expand access to health care.
- Abbott and the Abbott Fund are helping to address pediatric malnutrition in rural areas through continued expansion of nutrition education and supplement programs for school children, training and community education, reaching 65 schools and more than 1,700 children.
- Abbott and the Abbott Fund have supported Operation Smile's efforts to perform more than 920 surgeries to repair childhood facial deformities and train more than 360 medical personnel in Vietnam.
- Abbott supports CARE's efforts to strengthen community-based detection and reporting of Avian Influenza to help reduce disease transmission.
